Biography – Dr. Wijesinghe received B.Sc. from the Faculty of Science at the University of Peradeniya. Thereafter he read for his PhD in Biochemistry and Molecular Biology at Virginia Commonwealth University (VCU) School of Medicine. His graduate research involved the study of bioactive sphingolipids, the kinetics of their biosynthetic enzymes and their quantitation in various biological fluids and cell models using mass spectrometry. He continued this work into his postdoctoral training investigating the role of sphingolipids in human dermal wound healing. Following this, he joined VCU as the assistant director of the VCU lipidomics/metabolomics core facility before joining VCU School of Pharmacy as an assistant professor for clinical and translational research.
